

# FABRIC GUIDE

## FABRIC ACCEPTANCE RULES

To maintain quality and fairness in the swap, all fabric donations must meet the following criteria:

- ✂ **Minimum size:** We accept fabric in 1-yard increments or bundled half-yard pieces totaling at least 1 yards. Fabric will be measured down to the nearest 1/2 yard. EX 1 yard 24 inches will be measured as 1.5 yards.
- ✓ **Condition:** Fabrics must be clean, free of strong odors, and without large stains, rips, or holes.
- 🧵 **Accepted fabric types:** Cotton, linen, wool, polyester, specialty fabrics (such as sequins, leather, suede, faux fur, beaded fabric), and printed fabrics.
- 📏 **Width requirement:** Fabrics must be at least 45" wide unless they are special occasion panels.
- 📁 **Sorting:** If possible, please separate fabrics by category when donating.
- ✗ **Unaccepted items:** Notions, yarn, sewing machines, heavily damaged fabrics, and fabrics smaller than the minimum requirements.
- ⚠ **Please be patient while our volunteers inspect and measure your fabric.** There may be a short wait. If any fabric does not meet the guidelines, you will need to take it back with you.
